WHY SEND YOUR YOUTH LEADERS TO NYLT?


As Scout leaders you must go through training to be in your position (New Leader Essentials, Leader Specific, OLS). Why shouldn't a scout have to as well?

What is National Youth Leadership Training?

What are Participant Requirements?

Boy Scouts:

- 14-17 years of age by course
- First Class, or higher rank
- Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader, or other Troop Leadership position, or potential to be.
- Scoutmaster Nomination



Venturing Crew Members:

- 14 - 20 years of age by course
- Advisor's recommendation
