# WOOD BADGE

## What is Wood Badge?

Wood Badge is Scouting's advanced adult leadership skills training course. The course focuses on strengthening leadership skills, and improving every adult leader's ability to work with groups of youth and adults.

Incorporating leadership concepts that are used in corporate America, the course takes place within the constructs of a Scouting unit, living and experiencing the spirit of Scouting.

Among the topics covered are: valuing people, team development, situational leadership, problem solving, managing conflict, listening, and communicating.



## Who can attend?

- Volunteers and professionals in Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting and Venturing.
- Wood Badge is intended for adult Scouters in all leadership positions from all branches of Scouting.

## Where?

- Camp Conestoga, Bakersville, PA.
- Meals and tents will be provided on the first weekend.
- Personal tents and patrol cooking required on the second weekend.



## When?

- Friday, August 9, 2013 at 7:30 AM to Sunday, August 11, 2013 at 5:00 PM and
- Friday, Sept. 6, 2013 at 7:30 AM to Sunday, Sept. 8, 2013 at 4:30 PM
- One patrol meeting between the two weekends - date, time and place to be determined by your patrol.

**Attendance at both weekends and the patrol meeting is required.**

## What does it cost?

**Course fee \$250**

- Deposit of \$75 due at registration.
- Payment of \$75 due by May 3, 2013.
- Final payment of \$100 due by July 1, 2013.

**Course fee must be paid in full by July 1, 2013.**
