By providing a fun-filled, hands-on training in the outdoors, IOLS is designed to help Leaders gain confidence in their ability through hands-on, practical application of skills and proven methods of influencing growth in positive ways to achieve the purposes of the BSA.

Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools, ropes and knots, first aid, planning campfire programs, map and compass skills, hiking and packing techniques and Leave No Trace. By teaching and implementing the Patrol Method, participants will live like a Scout and learn the importance of the structured Patrol.
