## AMERICAN RED CROSS WILDERNESS & REMOTE FIRST AID COURSE (WFA)

**REQUIRED CPR & AED CERTIFICATION** prior to start of the course

**Note:** First Aid skills will be very helpful, but not required

**WHERE:** Eberly Scout Reservation (Camp Buck Run)

**WHEN:** May 3 thru May 5, 2019 (class begins at 6 p.m. Friday and ends around 5 p.m. Sunday) 16 hours

**WHAT:** Upon successful completion of the WFA COURSE, you will receive a RED CROSS certification indicating WFA - which is valid for two years. Successful course completion requires participation in all course activities & skill sessions. Some practice session may require strenuous or uneven terrain. Wear layers of clothing appropriate for weather conditions. (May be laying &.or kneeling on wet surfaces.)

**WHO:** Registered Scouts/Scouters. Youth must be 14 years of age by the start of the of the course.

**NEED:** Completed BSA Health form. (Note on registration form any medical &/or physical conditions that may require an accommodation). You are encouraged to check with your health care provider before participating in the required skill sessions of this course.

**COST:** \$90.00 Covers: use of cabin, meals, supplies & Red Cross Certification

**DEADLINE TO REGISTER:** April 18, 2019  
must have 8 registered participants. Cut off at 20 participants  
If slots fill up, a wait list will be maintained

**WHY** The primary purpose of the WILDERNESS FIRST AID COURSE (WFA) is to provide individuals a foundation of first aid knowledge & skills to be able to respond to emergencies and give care. Many areas do not have immediate emergency medical services who are able to respond to emergencies and give care, such as remote environments. In this course you will develop leadership skills and learn how to plan for, prevent and respond to emergencies
