- Applications for reservations of facilities must be submitted *two weeks* prior to event.
- Non-Scout Organizations and out of Council units must submit a certificate of insurance with the application.
- A \$40.00 deposit is required within *one week* of any reservation involving the use of a building or showerhouse. This deposit will be deducted from the total cost of the activity/event. Any cancellations less than two weeks before the reserved dates will result in the loss of the deposit.
- Any Unit that completes an approved service project totaling at least **four hours** will have their fees for the weekend waived. All service projects must be approved by the Camp Ranger or the Council Properties Committee.

## **Camp Use Policies:**

- 1. Everyone using the camp is expected to conduct themselves according to the Scout Oath and Law.
- 2. Each group must have one adult who is 21 or over and a second adult who is at least 18. There must be an adult present with the group at all times. Anyone leaving camp is expected to sign in/out with the Campmaster.
- 3. Groups must check in with the Campmaster before starting to set up camp. He will have a key for any buildings and areas that are deemed usable.
- 4. Camporee Chairperson are to report to the Campmaster upon arrival.
- 5. All vehicles must be parked in the area designated by the Council. No vehicles are to be parked in the camping areas.
- 6. No living trees are to cut or damaged.
- 7. Grounds and building must be left in clean condition to the satisfaction of the Campmaster.
- 8. Group is expected to bring plastic bags and remove ALL trash.
- 9. Where it applies, the group is expected to leave an adequate wood supply for the next group.
- 10. Adult leaders should check in with the Campmaster an appropriate fire precaution. No open flames in tents.
- 11. Alcohol, illegal drugs, fireworks, and firearms are not permitted.
- 12. All accidents and illness must be reported to the Campmaster immediately.
- 13. Each co-ed group must provide an adult female as one of the leaders for the entire camp stay and must abide by the policies and procedures set forth by the BSA for co-ed groups.
- 14. Damage to camp facilities must be reported to the Campmaster and the group will be expected to pay the costs of repair/replacement.
- 15. Group is encouraged to arrange with the Campmaster to perform "Good Turn" while in camp.
- 16. The rules governing the use of Ruth Rhoda Lake at Camp Conestoga and other program areas are:
  - a. No swimming at anytime.
  - b. Fishing is allowed by camping groups according to Pa. Fish Commission Laws.
  - c. Archery and rifle ranges may be used with the prior special permission and with a properly certified instructor in charge.
- 17. The Campmaster must inspect the camping area and complete the inspection form before the group leaves camp.
- 18. Adult leaders are expected to review these policies with all campers before arrival at camp.
- 19. In the event of Unit Cancellation- Units are required to notify the Council Office and Campmaster
