ACTIVITY STATIONS

FIRE WITHOUT FLAMES

Patrols will be tasked to gather materials from the surrounding area and build a small fire. Patrols will be provided with coffee cans and soapy water. Winner will be patrol whose water boils first.

THE TWIST

Patrols must start fire **WITH OUT** the use of matches or lighters, but may use other forms of ignition (friction, flint & steel, magnifying glass, steel wool and battery, etc). CHEMICAL REACTIONS, EXPLOSIVES AND FIREARMS PROHIBITED.

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY PATROL/TROOP

Ignition starters (friction, flint & steel, magnifying glass, steel wool & battery).

GOAL

Scouts learn other fire starting methods which can be used in emergency situations.

A TO Z SCAVENGER HUNT

Patrols will be given a bag and tasked to find items that begins with each letter of the alphabet.

THE TWIST

Items can be used for multiple letters (a nickel can be a coin, metal, round, flat, etc.). Patrol with fewest items wins.

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY PATROL/TROOP

Imagination.

GOAL

Scouts learn how to use their imagination and work together to achieve a common goal.

FOLLOW THE CLUES COMPASS COURSE

Patrols will be given a compass bearing, distance and a riddle which contains a clue to their next destination. At that destination they will find another bearing, distance and clue which will lead them to the next, ect.

THE TWIST

The compass bearing, distance and clues will be vague.

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY PATROL/TROOP

Compasses.

GOAL

Land navigation and problem solving, teamwork.

BLINDFOLDED OBSTACLE COURSE

Patrols will line up and navigate a simple obstacle course (small rocks, roots, low branches).

THE TWIST

All scouts will be blindfolded except the patrol leader who will lead from the rear of the line.

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY PATROL/TROOP

NOTHING.

GOAL

Leadership, attention to detail, following instruction.

LOST AND SCARED

Patrols will be tasked with finding a missing, injured person.

THE TWIST

Patrols will search for missing person, access their injuries proform basic treatment, safely transport them to a pre-selected area and treat injuries.

GOAL

Basic SAR and first aid skills

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY PATROL/TROOP

Back back size or easy to carry first aid kit.
