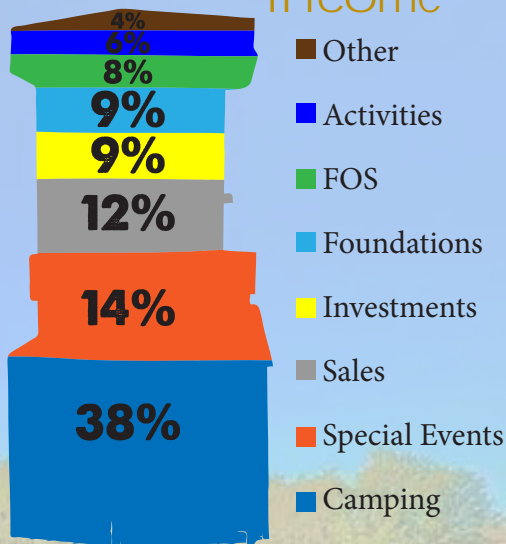

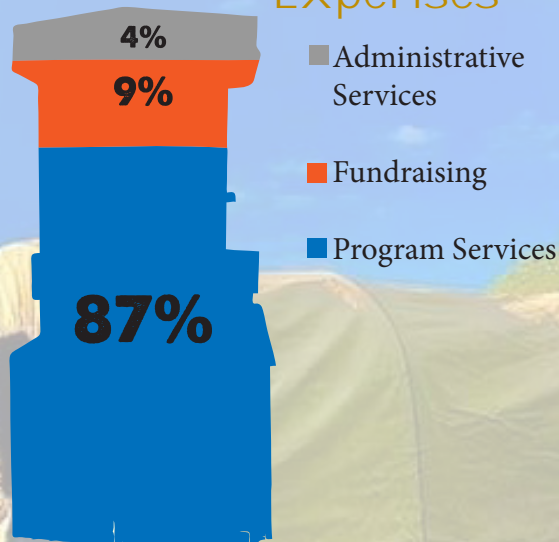

Camp Conestoga History

- 1949** — Camping at Conestoga begins along with construction of the Dining Hall.
- 1955** — A change in State Park policy paved the road for the construction of the Rifle Range.
- 1956** — The first long term lease was issued by the Laurel Hill State Park.
- 1957** — The swimming pool is constructed by American Bridge, division of US Steel.
- 1976** — Leased land amount was reduced from 350 acres to 275 acres.
- 1981** — The volunteer maintenance group known as the “Weekend Warriors” is formed.
- 1987** — Ruth Rhoda Lake construction is completed.
- 1992** — The climbing tower was built.
- 1998** — The council executive board coined the name Eberly Scout Reservation to include Camp Conestoga and Camp Buck Run.
- 2000** — Rohrbacher’s Lodge is constructed providing a central home to the camp office, health lodge, maintenance records, as well as a central conference room for meetings and trainings.
- 2020** — Eberly Scout Reservation is the only summer camp facility to operate in the Northeast region amidst the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2021** — In conjunction with the 100th Anniversary of Wagion Lodge 6, the OA Lodge is renovated into a fully functioning training center.
- 2024** — Camp Conestoga celebrates 75 years of operations!
