## **Bushy Run District Webelos/AOL Weekend 2024**

## **Information for TROOPS**

- Webelos/AOL Weekend will be held at the Hill at Camp Conestoga
- TROOPS should plan to arrive on Friday, Sept. 13, after 4:00 PM
  - BSA Standard Medical Form Part A/B is required at registration
  - Drop your gear at your campsite
  - Set up camp (bring your own tents!)
  - Designate and reserve an area in the same site for Webelos/AOLs, Cub Scout leaders and parents
- You will be teaching Webelos/AOLs how BSA camping is done
  - Bring any training materials that you will need for your session. If you need any help with that, please let us know early. Keep in mind that the Cub Scout program changed on June 1, 2024, so Adventures have different requirements.
  - Assist with pitching tents, etc.
- The troop will be responsible for all meals for the Webelos/AOLs, their leaders and parents – lunch and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday
  - The troop will be reimbursed for actual food costs up to \$15 per Cub Scout, Cub Leader, and Cub Parent. Please submit your receipts to Camp Director.
    - You will be given an exact headcount after registration closes on 9/4
- Communications in camp will utilize FRS radios
  - At least one Troop Leader in each campsite or activity area should have one with them at all times
  - If you do not have one, we can provide one
- There will be limited electricity
  - Hot and Cold water will be available in the Hill shower house.
  - A lantern/flashlight is recommended for nighttime
- We will make our best effort to match Packs with Troops
  - Put on your best face; this is a great opportunity for recruitment
  - Some areas have greater population density than others and mismatches will undoubtedly occur. The Packs will rotate through sessions, so you will have the opportunity to interact with all of the Cub Scouts in attendance.
  - Be sure to follow all BSA requirements for leadership assignments, tent assignments, etc.; Note that Troop members may not share a tent with a Webelos/AOL due to age gap concerns
  - There will be an opportunity for each troop to present its "story" to all of the campers, so come prepared with a brief intro, handouts with contact info, etc.
