

2015 School Night Plan Memorandum of Understanding

I, _____ of Pack _____ (Here forth referred to as PACK), enter into agreement with the Westmoreland Fayette Council, Inc. Boy Scouts of America (further referred to as WFBSA) to obtain a paper back copy of the handbook for the corresponding rank for all NEW Cub Scouts who sign up on my District Designated Sign Up night.

Should the PACK fail to comply with the following WFBSA guidelines the PACK will not be eligible for the free book program. Coupons for books will be distributed upon the submission of a completed, paid, youth application.

WFBSA reserves the rights to cancel, terminate, change, or substitute other items in the free book program due to unforeseen funding restrictions.

The following guidelines are required:

- A PACK representative(s) must attend one of the WFBSA Program Planning meetings:
 - May 13th
 - Brush Creek Evangelical Lutheran Church (Irwin) OR
 - Morell Fire Department (Dunbar)
 - May 21st - Charter Oak Church (Greensburg)
- The PACK must attend one of the WFBSA Membership Corn Roasts:
 - Laurel Hills – August 11th
 - Bushy Run – August 12th
 - Old Trails – August 12th
- Prior to September 1 each PACK must ensure the correct information is listed on BeAScout.org, assistance in updating a pin may be obtained by contacting the WFBSA Service Center (724.837.1630).
- Each PACK must invite a WFBSA District Volunteer, Staff Member or Commissioner to attend your School Night.
- PACKS must publicize their School Night event using one method other than the basic school distributed flyers, verification of the publicity should be sent to the WFBSA via your District Executive.
- The WFBSA School Night agenda must be followed at your School Night Event.
- Applications for new Cub Scouts must be turned in at the nearest Drop-off Location directly following your approved School Night event. Those not received that same night will not be eligible for free books.
