Early Bird Registration Fees

*Early Bird Registration runs from **April 1, 2014** to **May 9, 2014***

Tot Lot- \$15.00*: This pays for t-shirts, activities, and lunch all 3 days.

Late Registration Fees

*Late Registration runs from **May 10, 2014** to **May 30, 2014**. **No exceptions!***

Cub Scouts- \$60.00*: This pays for t-shirts, patches, all activities, and lunch all 3 days.

Adult Walkers- \$15.00: This pays for t-shirts, and lunch all 3 days.

Tot Lot- \$15.00*: This pays for t-shirts, activities, and lunch all 3 days.

This year, postcards will be distributed with information about Day Camp and registration. Postcards will be mailed and/or distributed to each family.

New in 2014!

This year, groups will be RANK based, not PACK based. While this may seem like a major change, and it is, this will ultimately provide a better and more age appropriate program for all participants. By organizing groups by rank, advancement requirements will be incorporated into the day camp program. This will give Scouts in your dens & packs a jump start on the upcoming year. All the Cub Scouts of the same rank from one pack will be kept together and put in a group with other Cub Scouts of the same rank from other packs.

Pack News

All packs must have a Day Camp Representative who will turn in all payments, health forms, and registration transmittals to the Council Office. Each pack should turn in ONE check.

Each pack MUST provide 1 adult for every 4 campers attending- no exceptions! This ratio can be fulfilled by 1 adult walker for all 3 days or a combination of 2 or 3 adult walkers providing coverage for the 3 days.

We are asking each pack to send one person to help run a station each day of camp. *Please remember, without volunteers we do not have a camp!*

Tot Lot Campers

This is a service provided to the Day Camp Walkers and Staff with children who are not participating in the general camp (boys ages 3 to 7, girls ages 3 to 12). Children must be fully potty trained. Snacks will be provided by the Tot Lot staff to prevent any kind of allergic reactions that some of our campers may have. There is absolutely NO outside food allowed in Tot Lot. Parents with children in Tot Lot also need to be aware if your child's behavior is inappropriate or may cause harm to themselves or other camps, or staff members they will be asked to remain with their child for the remainder of the day or the child will be asked to leave camp. No refunds will be given.

General Notes

All Cub Scouts, Tots, and Adults should bring the following items each day: A backpack, raingear, sunscreen, and a water bottle with their name on it.

There will be a Trading Post again this year. The items available will be different than in years past.

Activities will include fishing, archery, bb guns, an obstacle course, games, crafts, and more!
