

PA BACKGROUND CHECKS

The state of Pennsylvania requires that all Volunteers that are involved with children must take the following background checks to be qualified to be a leader in the Boy Scouts of America:

- 1. Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Background checks**
- 2. Pennsylvania Child Abuse Background checks**
- 3. FBI Background Checks (Living in Pennsylvania 10 years or less)**
- 4. Volunteer Affidavit (Living in Pennsylvania 10 Years or more)**

Volunteers that do not comply with this ordinance **will not** be registered in the Boy Scouts of America. Charters **will not** be processed if the background check paperwork is not turned into the office.

The penalty for having a volunteer registered without the background checks is **\$10,000 per person**.

The best way to keep track of the background checks is to keep copies for the **unit**, give a copy to the **council**, and the **individual** should keep a copy for themselves. This will keep everyone's records in check.
