Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday

Immediately following lunch
Course approximately 3 hours long each day

The Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) Course builds and expands on the concepts and themes introduced in Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training, and provides Scouters with the confidence to take youth in the outdoors. Attendance at all three daily sessions is required to complete this training.



Scouts BSA Position Specific Training Thursday

Immediately following breakfast

Course approximately 1-4 hours long, depending on your registered position

Returning for 2023! The BSA has redesigned position specific training for **Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Troop Committee Chairs, Troop Committee Members and Merit Badge Counselors**. The new training recognizes participation in modules that are required for multiple positions within the Scouts BSA program.

The training begins with foundational background information beneficial to all Scouts BSA volunteers. As modules complete for your position, you are free to remain and complete other modules or you may leave at that time.

This training completely satisfies the Position Training Requirements for Troop Committee Chairs, Troop Committee Members and Merit Badge Counselors. This training is one of 3 required courses for Scoutmasters and Asst. Scoutmasters– the other two consisting of Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (also offered at camp) and Weather Hazards Training (available online).
